Before There Was Manifesting...

1. How can manifesting be good, and how can it be a knock-off spirituality?
2. Re-read Mark 11:12-25. Compare the behavior of the Israelites in verses 12-21 with Jesus's call to action in verses 22-25.
3. In the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13), Jesus teaches us to pray for our specific needs and for His will to be done. Do you do a good job of praying for both?
4. What would it look like to use some manifesting practices hand-in-hand with regular prayer?
5. Read Romans 8:26-28. What is the comfort in this passage for when we don't know what to pray for? When all we know how to is "Your will be done," what assurance do we have?
